

ATHLETIC ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY FOR GRANDVIEW HEIGHTS MIDDLE SCHOOL

(as excerpted from the GHMS Parent Student Handbook, 2007-2008)

Athletic Eligibility

For any student to be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities, the following standards have been adopted by the Board of Education:

Weekly Eligibility - F = 2 points

D = 1 point

When a student has accumulated 3 or more points during one week, a one-week grace period will be allowed before the student becomes ineligible. Once ineligibility begins, it continues for the following entire week. An entire week of ineligibility begins on Tuesday and runs through the following Monday. If a sufficient number of deficiency points are removed the student still maintains ineligible status until a new week of eligibility begins on the following Tuesday.

*The grace period may be used only once during a grading period and begins with the first reporting of ineligibility. Grades are cumulative from the beginning of the current grading period.

Grading Period Eligibility

A student must pass 75% of classes from the preceding grading period and maintain a minimum of 1.67 accumulative grade point average to be eligible to participate each succeeding grading period. Once eligibility is reestablished, weekly monitoring begins again on the tenth calendar day of each grading period from the conclusion of the preceding grading period.

Spring Quarter to fall of next school year

To be eligible to participate in fall sports, students must pass 75% of classes during the fourth nine weeks and have maintained a minimum of 1.67 accumulative grade point average.

**In accordance with Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA) rules summer school attendance CANNOT be used to establish eligibility. For new students entering the Grandview Heights schools, OHSAA standards only must be met. After the student has been in attendance for a full grading period, then the above requirements are added.
