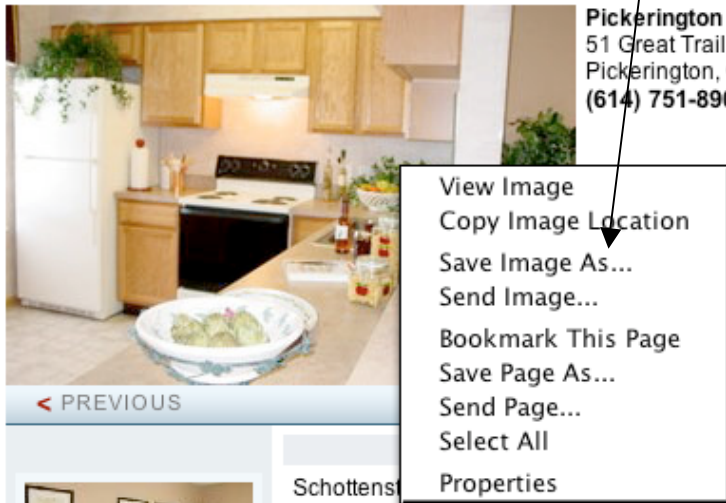


3 WAYS TO GET IMAGES

Saving from the Internet

Find your image on the Internet. “Right-click” by holding down the CTRL button and clicking on the image. Choose Save Image As, or Download Image to Disk. Choose where you’d like it to save it. You may change the name but leave the file extension (.gif or .jpg)



Copying from the Internet

Find your image on the Internet. “Right-click” by holding down the CTRL button and clicking on the image. Choose Copy. Choose where you’d like it to save it. You may change the name but leave the file extension (.gif or .jpg). Some images are copyrighted and will not allow you to copy.

Taking a Screen Shot

Simultaneously press Apple-Shift-4. Your cursor will change shape. Click and hold, then drag an area you would like to capture. When you release your mouse button the file will automatically appear on your desktop and be labeled Picture 1.

If you press Apple-Shift-3, this will capture the entire desktop and then place the image on your desktop.
